Broadly, the Combined Radio Clubs Committee is looking at possible changes in the N.S.W. Division's constitution and functions, and in particular to formulate some means of arranging for Club's representation on the State Body.

In general the Committee of this Society is in agreement with the establishment of a Body composed of representatives from local Amateur Clubs, but we will await further considerations by the Combined Radio Clubs Committee before we make any formal resolutions. Also, in general, we feel that such a State representative Body should not be heavily committed financially or legally as appears to be the present position of the W.I.A.
