## Oscar Satellite News.

Oscar 7 - Not a lot of activity on Mode B passes recently checked, but it varies.

Oscar 8— Mode J (2 metres up - 70 cm down) is very interesting because of the variety of Signal strength reports. Sudden changes in strength on my own downlink signal has been noted on some recent evening passes, with the signal increasing from S1 to S6 over a second or two and remaining at about this level for the remainder of the pass, even though no other signals were heard during this period. This could be consistent with antenna shielding by the satellite during portion of the pass rather than polarisation shift.

More detailed tracking information for Oscar 8 should be available shortly.

A frequency scanning system is being set up which will allow the full passband to be monitored. This may help to determine fading patterns for different signals being simultainously received.

Does anyone in the Illawarra or mid South Coast area have information on Oscar 7 & 8 Mode A operation that I can include in these notes?
