VK2RIL 147.275

This repetaer has turned into a triffid and uprooted itself and found a temporary new home. It is presantly located on one of the towers at Maddens Plains. There has been a noticeable difference in signal around the place, some good, some bad. However, do not take too much notice of what you have at the moment, as the antenna that is being used is not designed for the repeater has suspect feedline attached to it and the antenna itself is situated on the wrong side of the tower from where it will eventually be.

A working bee has been organized for the 19/11/95 to rectify these problems and to install 70cm and maybe a link. What is needed most is some of you with your own safety harnesses and a bit of climbing ability as there is some LDF 550 at our disposal, but ti has to be moved down the tower and relocated properly.

SOME THINGS TO REMEMBER


